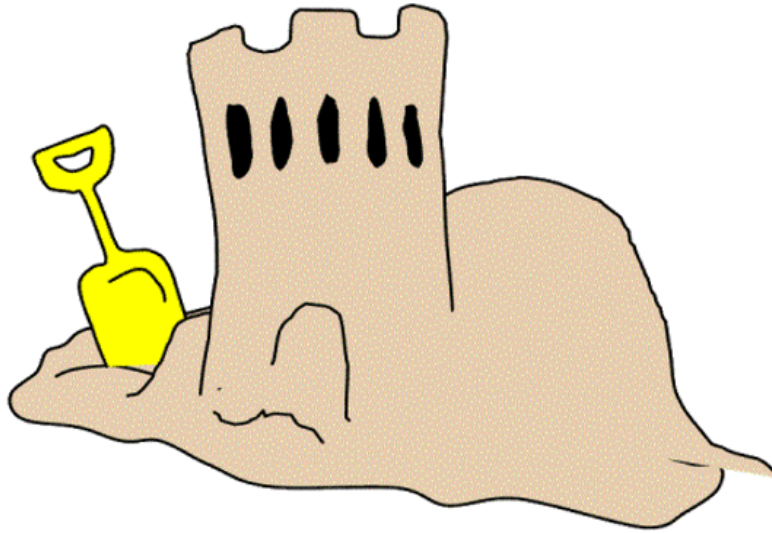

How to use word cards with your child.

Review the list. Cut out the flash cards.

Activity 1 Place three cards on the table. Name one of the words. Ask your child to find that word.

Activity 2 Say a sentence with a missing word. (The ducks ____ on the pond.) Again display three word cards and ask your child to choose the one that belongs in the sentence.

Activity 3 Say a word that is not from the list. Ask your child to find a word card that rhymes with your word. This will not work with all the words.

Activity 4 Have your child make up sentences using the word cards.

When your child has mastered the words, you may flash the cards for review. Flashing cards is not a good way to learn the words.
